Trebbiano D'Abruzzo 2014, Gran Sasso, Abruzzo <i>A fresh and zesty Trebbiano with aromas of fresh apple & pear fruit. The palate is fresh & clean, pear fruit with balancing acidity & persistent length.</i>	£20.75
Fiano 2014, Mezzogiorno, Puglia <i>From the heel of Italy this rich & vibrant Fiano transports us to the sunshine. Acacia scented with ripe peach, almond and pineapple. Its natural crisp acidity makes it dangerously drinkable.</i>	£22.00
Pecorino 2014, Caldora, Abruzzo <i>Complex nose, ripe pear fruit with hints of stone fruit & citrus with a slight savoury note. The palate is mouth-filling and provides lovely texture, ripe pear fruit once again dominates with a refreshing balancing citrus acidity.</i>	£27.25

'Toh' Friulano 2014, Di Lenardo, Friuli Venezia <i>A gentle and approachable style of Friulano, soft, round and mouth filling. Ripe stone & exotic fruits with hints of spice and almond with clean balancing mineral acidity and lovely length. A wonderful match with charcuterie or richer fish dishes. An alternative to Chardonnay albeit a little drier with a fresher finish.</i>	£29.50
Terlaner Classico 2014, Cantina Terlano, Alto Adige <i>Elegant & harmonious. Ripe tropical flavours, soft white fruit and lovely floral notes with balancing (classic Terlano) mineral acidity. The wine has a long persistent finish.</i>	£33.50
Langhe Bianco 2014, 'Dragan'Luigi Baudana, Piedmont <i>Dry floral and summer grass perfumes are supported by distinct mineral notes and a savoury, lifted character on the palate. Predominantly Chardonnay & Sauvignon with touches of Riesling and Nascetta giving extra elegance & a long refreshing finish</i>	£36.00
'Vie di Romans' Chardonnay 2012, Vie di Romans, Isonzo, Friuli <i>This Chardonnay made from single vineyard, hand selected grapes is stunning. The oak integrates perfectly with the fruit & it has a length of flavour & complexity that is seldom found outside of Burgundy.</i>	£50.50

Viognier 2014, Baron de Badassière, Languedoc <i>A fresh, modern style viognier. Offering subtle aromas of almond and honey on the nose. Rounded on the palate with flavours of peach and apricot, balanced by a refreshing acidity on the finish.</i>	£22.00

Vermentino 2014, Domaine les Yeuses, Languedoc - Roussillon	£22.75
<i>Fragrant lemon and apricot, with undertones of Mediterranean herbs. Full of flavour & character with the fresh acidity typical of the variety. A very sophisticated wine at its price level.</i>	
Picpoul de Pinet 2015, Château de la Mirande, Languedoc	£24.00
<i>One of the very few French appellations which also bears the name of the grape. Often referred to as the 'Muscadet of the South', with its minerality & almost saltiness on the nose from its close proximity to the sea. Surprising complex white with flavours of pears & citrus fruit & fennel, and a zesty finish.</i>	
Reserve De Gassac Blanc 2014, Mas de Daumas Gassac, Roussillon	£25.25
<i>This blend of Viognier and Marsanne from a world famous estate has an attractive nose of ripe pears, apple-blossom and honey. Fleshy fruit on the palate and a surprisingly fresh grapefruit finish. Organic</i>	
Petit Bourgeois Sauvignon 2014, Henri Bourgeois, Loire	£26.75
<i>Flower and fruit fragrances: elderflower, gooseberry & green notes of peppers & pea shoots, very crisp fruit but with good weight. The dimensions of a good Sancerre.</i>	
Bergerac Blanc 'Cuvee des Conti' 2014, Ch Tour des Gendres, Bergerac	£27.75
<i>A classic Bordeaux blend. This creamy Sémillon Sauvignon spends eight months on the lees and a month in barriques. Imagine waxy peaches and sweet cashews with a dash of ginger, cumin and white pepper. Organic</i>	
Bourgogne Aligote 2013, Goisot, Cotes d'Auxerre, Burgundy - Organic	£32.50
<i>Aligote is the 'other' white grape variety of Burgundy. A complex wine with a nose of lemon & apple & notes of flint. On the palate the apple combines with a hint of spice, apricot & a toasty creaminess. Lovely acidity & minerality.</i>	
Riesling Tradition 2014, Albert Mann, Alsace - Organic	£34.50
<i>Appealingly clean, aromatic nose with pure lemon citrus aromas. Dry and fine in the mouth this organic Riesling reveals more citrus notes (grapefruit, lime and a hint of pearskin), taut and mineral with a long, lime-streaked finish.</i>	
Chablis 2014, Domaine Adhemar et Francois Boudin, Burgundy	£38.75
<i>Classic Chablis, with a very pretty nose and a mildly buttery edge rounding out that mineral, pebbly Chablis character. The ripeness adds an extra fullness and depth, and makes this a great wine to drink young.</i>	
Sancerre 2014, Domaine Vincente Delaporte, Loire	£39.75
<i>A full flavoured Sancerre from classic 'silex' soils, a perfect balance of fruit, finesse, aromatic complexity and minerality. Great purity of fruit and perfectly balanced acidity; a fine wine</i>	
Saint Veran 'En Crêches' 2012, Domaine Daniel Barraud, Burgundy	£44.50
<i>A wonderful combination of lush & spicy fruit that is typical to the Macon Vergisson. Great richness, breadth and weight, with nicely concentrated flavours that possess a pretty undertone of minerality, and fine finishing balance, flavour & complexity that is seldom found outside of Burgundy.</i>

Vinho Verde 2014, Arca Nova, Vinho Verde, Portugal	£21.75
<i>This is the perfect summer afternoon aperitif. Made from handpicked local grapes Loureiro & Pedernã, it is light with refreshing acidity & a slight spritz. Surprising depth & roundness. Extremely drinkable!</i>	
Síria 2014, Quinta dos Currais, Beira Interior, Portugal	£24.00
<i>Grown in mountainous granite soil, this wine made from 100% Síria has a lovely minerality & freshness from its altitude. Elegant & delicate with floral notes & citrus tinged fruit. Refreshing acidity makes for a lovely aperitif.</i>	
Godello Do Monterrei 2014, Mara Martin, Galicia, Spain	£26.75
<i>From one of the most influential producers in Galicia, this delicious and unusual wine from the Godello grape is bone dry with notes of apple & pear & a citrus tang on the finish</i>	
Vinhas do Lasso 2012, Quinta do Pinto, Estremadura, Portugal	£28.50
<i>From the coastal region of Estremadura to the north of Lisbon, this gorgeous white is a blend of local grapes Arinto, Fernão Pires and Antão Vaz. It is rich and textured, floral and apricot-tinged with hints of honey and a fresh, mineral-laced kick on the finish.</i>	
Albariño 2014, Zarate, Rias Baixa, Spain - Biodynamic	£36.50
<i>Albariño as it should be from one of the best producers in Rias Baixas. Minerality and balance in a bottle, very focused and tight, like a good Chablis. Hidden amongst the steely character of the wine, stone fruits such as peach and apricot lurk— totally delicious!</i>	

Rest of Europe

Zenit 2013, Tornai Somolo, Hungary – New	£24.50
<i>Aromas of pear and peach on the nose & fine acidity supports a refreshingly fruity palate. Besides the freshness there is richness of flavors and aromas with plenty of excitement on the finish. Beautiful length & amazing value!</i>	
Grüner Veltliner 2014, Huber, Austria	£26.50
<i>Aromas of ripe, juicy pear and white peach with aromatic spice, and a mouth wateringly fresh touch. Powerful yet elegant, pure and finely balanced with a mineral acidity and hints of white pepper.</i>	

Rivaner 2014, Mathis Bastian, Luxembourg – New £28.00
100% Rivaner, a cross between Riesling & Sylvaner & more commonly known as Muller-Thurgau. This vibrant wine displays a beautifully bright nose with aromas of greengage and grapefruit. Lively and refreshing on the palate with lip-smacking lemon tinged acidity and an off-dry finish make this the perfect aperitif wine.

Riesling 2014, Mehrlein Mittelheimer Edlmann, Rheingau, Germany £30.50
This dry style of Riesling has a pure lime citrus fruit character and a stony minerality. The palate is very precise with just a hint of texture and a cleansing acidity. Perfect as an aperitif or with oily fish dishes.

Weisser Burgunder Kabinett 2012, Rebholz, Pfalz, Germany £35.00
A focussed & pure example of Pinot Blanc. Clean & bright aromas of white fruits, light spice & hints of talc! The lively palate has an unfolding concentration of fruit supported by brilliantly clean & dry mineral acidity. Powerful fruit & spice to finish

Rosé

Côtes De Provence ‘Cuvée Elegance’ 2014, Carteron, Provence, France £27.25
Prettily fragrant with a bouquet of red berry fruits & sweet jasmine. Dry, elegant, shimmering acidity and vibrant summer fruits, with a brush-stroke of Chablis-like minerality.

Italy

Sangiovese 2014, Rubicone, Vinvita, Emilia Romagna £18.00
Vibrant dark cherries & blueberries from this modern producer of Sangiovese in the heart of the northern region of Emilia Romagna. Unadulterated, clean and very enjoyable, it makes a great aperitif or will go with most meats & cheeses.

Pinot Nero 2013, Ca’ di Alte, Veneto £22.00
This attractive pinot puts many a Bourgogne rouge to shame with its lovely perfume of wild cherries & spice. On the palate juicy cherries & strawberries. Good length & a well balanced bargain!

Primitivo 2014, TenuteRubino, Puglia £25.00
Classic style Primitivo, an abundance of dark plums, blackberries & blueberries, soft tannins & a touch of liquorice & violets. A serious crowd pleaser & great value from the Southern tip of Italy.

Chianti Colli Senesi DOCG 2014, Salcheto, Tuscany – New £25.50
An easy drinking, everyday wine, part matured in American Oak to promote soft & elegant notes. Classic cherries & spice & served in the lightest & most ecological bottle on the market

Alberese IGT 2014, Fattoria di Sammontana, Tuscany—Organic £26.25
A nod to the old tradition that made Trebbiano a compulsory component of any Chianti blend (90% Sangiovese & 10% Trebbiano). Bright and fresh with clean, zippy red fruits and a savoury edge. The Trebbiano makes it as light and drinkable as a top Beaujolais.

Gran Passione Rosso 2014, IGT, Veneto £27.25
A blend of Corvina & Merlot, much like an Amarone the grapes are laid out to dry before squeezing to intensify the flavour. Vibrant purple in colour, rich luscious nose full of sweet ripe dark cherry, plum, vanilla and spice. Rich and velvety, with lots of juicy fruit. Very easy drinking.

Morellino Di Scansano ‘Bellamarsilia’ 2013, Argentiera, Tuscany £28.75
Plump and juicy Sangiovese packed with bright cherry fruit flavours, framed by supple, silky tannins. Tons of harmony and a long, finessed finish; a superb Tuscan red that won't break the bank!

Cannonau di Sardegna 2014, ‘Primo Scuro’, Cantina Mesa, Sardegna £29.00
Cannonau is said to have originated in Sardegna but is more widely known as Grenache or Garnacha. Deep ruby colour with generous fragrances of ripe wild fruit & berries, delicate notes of violets & the Mediterranean. The palate is warm, round & full bodied

Montepulciano d’Abruzzo ‘Yume’ 2011, Caldora, Abruzzo £34.00
A classic example of Montepulciano from this region, rich and concentrated, savoury and complex with an abundance of dark fruit combine with spices, dried herbs and sweet oak. The palate has concentration and power and delivers a beautiful glass of wine for those guests who particularly like bigger deeper red wines.

Rosso di Montefalco 2011, Adanti, Umbria – New £34.75
A traditional old school Sangiovese dominated wine, warm and attractive aromas that combine dark cherry and plum fruits, earthiness, spiciness and dried herbs. The palate is mid to full bodied yet provides a silky seamless texture, powerful, warm and inviting with firm structure and great persistence.

Langhe Nebbiolo 2014, Produttori del Barbaresco, Piedmont £36.75
Perfumed floral aromas, attractive red fruits, cherry & orange peel with underlying liquorice & spice. The palate has a lovely texture, fleshy red fruit with hints of earth & spice backed by firm tannins & fresh acidity. Beautifully balanced.

Cerasuolo di Vittoria 2012, Cos, Vittoria, Sicily	£45.00
<i>Sicilian blend of indigenous Frappato and Nero d'Avola grapes. Aromas of sweet violets and a whisper of spiced cherries. The wine is very smooth, almost silky and the bright berry flavours cascade over the tongue to their lip-smacking conclusion.</i>	
Rosso dell' Abazia 2008, Serafini & Vidotto, Veneto	£47.50
<i>This Italian cult wine is a Bordeaux blend of grapes from North of Venice. The wine is complex and powerful, intense cassis aromas, sweet & concentrated dark berry fruit with savoury hints of tobacco, earth & black olive with herbal /vegetal notes. The palate is rich & beautifully balanced and drinking so well now. Mouth filling fruit with a creamy texture & hints of oak.</i>	
Brunello di Montalcino 2008, Da Vinci, Tuscany	£59.50
<i>A traditional style of Brunello hailing from Southern Montalcino. Earthy & mineral hints integrate perfectly with the red fruit & oak spice. It combines both power and elegance while being very approachable.</i>	
Barolo 2007, Poderi Aldo Conterno, Monforte D'Alba, Piedmont	£74.50
<i>From one of the most historic names of Italian wine, the Conterno family have been making wine in Monforte since 1700's. This Barolo has a lovely depth & structure. To be drunk now or cellared for years to come.</i>

Saint-Cirice 2014, Domaine Saint-Cyrgues, Costieres de Nimes	£19.00
<i>A blend of Syrah, Grenache and Carignan, this wine shares the same soil & climate as its neighbours in the Southern Rhone. Perfumed with violets & mulberries & great concentration of fruit & spice on the palate.</i>	
Malbec 'Exception' 2014, Fabrice Durou, Cahors, France – New	£22.00
<i>A French Malbec from the region around Cahors, not fat and punchy as you know it from Argentina, but Malbec in its most pure, fruity and elegant form - succulent, bright & smooth. Very user friendly</i>	
Marcillac 'Lo Sang del Pais' 2014, Domaine du Cros, South West	£27.25
<i>Healthy purple-red colour, aromas of raspberries, myrtle and red currants, medium-bodied with sharp cherry flavours underpinned by distinctive mineral notes of iron and slate. Easy-drinking but very more-ish.</i>	
Côtes du Rhône 2011, Selection Laurence Feraud, Rhône– New	£28.75
<i>This blend of Syrah and Grenache has developed very nicely after few years of ageing. It still has layers of ripe fruit matched with Asian spices and some leather and liquorice notes.</i>	
Pinot Noir 'Puy-de-Dome' 2013, Cave Saint Verny, Auvergne	£29.00
<i>Not from Burgundy, but all the better for it. All the quality but not the price tag! Hints of herbs and ripe cherry fruit on the nose. The palate is elegant and textured with smooth, sappy red cherry fruit. Expressive & elegantly pure Pinot.</i>	
Saumur Champigny 2014, Domaine Des Roches Neuves, Loire, France	£29.75
<i>Classic Cabernet Franc, pure, fresh and expressive. Ripe smoky red and blueberry fruit, soothing gravelly notes and a hint of pepper on the finish. A versatile food wine.</i>	
Faugeres Tradition 2013, Clos Fantine, France - Biodynamic	£33.00
<i>Drinking this Faugeres will make you feel closer to nature. This is a crawl on the wild side: the fruit is meaty with game & garrigue notes of bay & roasted thyme & there is a pronounced, bonfire smokiness on the finish.</i>	
Prologue 2013, Christian Ducroux, Beaujolais, France – New	£35.00
<i>At only 10.5% alcohol, this Gamay from the village of Regnie in Beaujolais is dangerously drinkable. The nose is bright and pretty and the palate is filled with fresh herbs and tons of cranberries and redcurrant fruits. Have it chilled!</i>	
Le Petit Roy, 13eme année, Domaine Jean Royer, Southern Rhone	£35.50
<i>The vintage is in the name. A blend of Mourvedre, Grenache & Syrah. It has a lovely sappy-succulent character with plump, ripe & peppery fruit. Deceptively easy to drink, but essentially a succulent & gorgeous baby Châteauf-du-Pape.</i>	
Château Ducluzeau 2006, Lustrac-Medoc, Bordeaux	£45.00
<i>Immaculately made Margaux-styled wine. More linear and precise fruit than in the 2005 vintage, with very attractive and quite prominent new oak flavours and tannins which have integrated to make this a very fine claret indeed.</i>	
Saint Joseph '350 M' 2011, David Reynaud, Northern Rhone - Biodynamic	£46.00
<i>So named because the vineyards are situated at 350m above sea level. Full bodied wine with aromas of blackberry & fresh plums on the nose. Round on the palate, firm tannins, it has intense black fruits & spiceflavours, with a long finish.</i>	
Pommard 'Tavannes' 2011, Dom.Fernand & Laurent Pillot, Burgundy	£54.00
<i>A mouth-filling, perfume-y Pinot Noir from the village of Tavannes in Pommard. Winning cherry fruit, spice and mineral flavours framed by grippy but reassuringly fine tannins. Great length. One to consider if you're trying to convert a devotee of big reds to the pleasures of Burgundy.</i>	

Spain & Portugal

Douro Tinto 'Animus' 2013, Douro, Portugal

£24.00

Meaning "soul" in Latin, Animus is indeed a soulful wine. Made from carefully chosen parcels of indigenous Portuguese grape varieties also used in the finest ports. A palate of red fruits, cedar & grilled meat followed by spicy ripe fruit & soft tannins.

Garnacha 2014, Viña Zorzal, Navarra, Spain — Organic New

£25.50

This 100% Garnacha from Navarra delivers bags of lively and juicy strawberries. It has medium weight, very soft tannins and lots of freshness. Excellent with barbeques or spicy food.

Pontval 2013, Pontval, Vinho Regiona Alentejano, Portugal

£27.25

A blend of Alicante Bouschet, Syrah, Touriga Nacional & Petit Verdot. Vibrant rich fruit. Aged in Oak, this wine is all about the silky finish & round full bodied flavours. Just the right amount of seriousness for the fading daylight.

Bierzo 2014 Castro Ventosa Joven, Bierzo, Spain

£29.00

This 100% Mencía offers stunning value for money from the up-and-coming Bierzo region in northwest Spain. It is very fruit-forward but with some mineral and meaty undertones. The attack is crunchy and grippy yet it finishes dry and clean.

Rioja Reserva 2011, Izadi, Rioja, Spain - New

£33.00

Shiny ruby red in colour. Rich aromatic intensity and a nice balance of red fruit, liquorice and spices, with hints of smoke in the background. Elegant and round on the palate with a long aftertaste full of floral and ripe fruit notes.

Planella 2012, Montsant, Spain - Biodynamic

£37.75

Often associated with great value Priorat: same grapes, same climate, similar soils at a fraction of the price. The wines are deep, intense and powerful but balanced by an amazing freshness and minerality. This blend of Carignan, Syrah and a dash of Grenache has an elegance difficult to find in the region. Black fruit, savoury spices and hints of Provençal herbs.

The Rest of Europe

Zweigelt 2014 Johannesh of Reinisch, Austria - New

£29.50

Attractive dark berry and cherry fruits with distinctive peppery / spicy notes with hints of leafiness. The palate is juicy and fleshy, powerful fruit with softer tannins and refreshing acidity. A pleasure to drink.

Kekfrankos 'Balf' 2012, Weninger, Sopron, Hungary

£32.25

Also known as Blaufränkisch in Austria, Kekfrankos is the most widely planted red grape variety in Hungary. This dark skinned variety has an intense purple colour with an abundance of dark cherry fruit and black pepper. 20 months spent in small oak barrigues gives us notes of spice & chocolate. Think black forest gateaux — delicious!

Spätburgunder Tradition 2011, Rebholz, Pfalz, Germany

£52.00

An elegant style of Pinot Noir with beautiful perfumed aromas of raspberry & strawberry with underlying savoury, vegetal notes with spice & a light creaminess. The palate is a surprisingly powerful hit of red fruits, forest floor & spice. Continuously develops in the glass.
